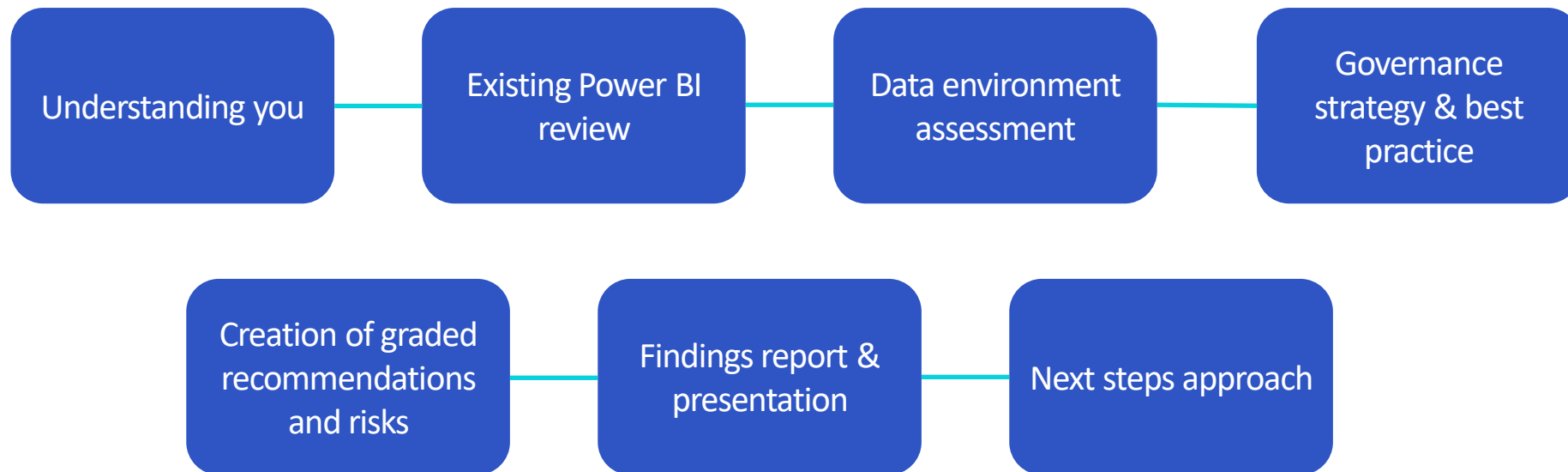
Harness the power of your organisation's data and create better experiences for your employees and customers with Power BI.

Understanding you

- › **Getting started** – Our first step in our Power BI Quickstart is to get to know you better. In order to tailor our approach and recommendations we need to understand your current situation. What is your current data approach, how important is it, how would you describe your Power BI usage.
 - › **Looking forward** – It is important for us to also understand your ambition in this area. What does your data strategy look like for the next 5 years. Are you looking to grow and mature in this space or just ensure better governance and management?

Existing Power BI review

- › **Your Power BI environment** – We require access to your Power BI environment to fully assess your usage. This will inform our recommendations and allow us to identify any risks within your current usage. Key to this is any existing processes and governance.
 - › **We will review:** Users, report & dashboard, data models, data sources, roles, processes and licensing.

Your data environment



- › Power BI doesn't stand alone, it is important to understand the role of your wider data environment.
 - › What data does your organisation have? What systems does it live in? How accessible is the data to Power BI users? What is the quality of the data like?
 - › We will provide a high level look at this as a factor in our recommendations. This is not a full data landscape assessment at this stage.

Findings report

- › **Findings report** – The findings report will provide a full assessment of Power BI, your requirements and existing approach. We will provide a Power BI strategy and governance approach that will deliver against your objectives and a clear roadmap for putting this into practice. We will also include a graded recommendations section, highlighting any risks, quick wins and next steps.
 - › **Presentation** – We feel that a presentation and walkthrough of the findings report is the best way to get value from the exercise. Ensuring you understand each risk and recommendation and providing the opportunity to discuss and ask questions.

Next steps



- › **Putting it into practice** – We tailor the next steps around your preferred approach. We generally approach it in 3 ways:
 - › **Fully supported** – For organisations requiring a partner to deliver the recommendations and implement the governance and strategy changes, we provide a full service around this.
 - › **Advisory** – For organisations requiring a partner to be available for ongoing guidance but would prefer to implement some or all changes themselves.
 - › **Quickstart only** – For more independent organisations that just require an assessment and outside opinion of their environment and approach.


